The following problems from Thomas 14E are suggested, either on MLP (electronic) or on paper. You can assign more problems or less, as you see fit, perhaps $\pm 20 \%$. But the ones in boldface are required; these should count into the students' grades in the form of homework or in-class work sheets. Eventually we may mandate approx 3 common problems per section; probably we should discuss this number. Feel free to suggest more problems, perhaps to take effect in Summer.
