## **Microbiology LAB Rules**

## Lab Rules

Any microbe used in this laboratory is considered a **potential pathogen.** It is necessary to work with a set of rules that will preclude the possibility that a student or instructor becomes infected by microorganisms used in this class.

- 1. **Before each lab** and **at the completion** of each lab you must **wipe your lab bench thoroughly with disinfectant.**
- 2. Do not keep personal items on the lab bench.
- 3. There will be NO Smoking

NO Eating or Drinking

NO pencils, fingers, etc. in the mouth or other body parts.

- 4. Shoes must be worn at all times.
- 5. An outer protective garment must be worn (lab coat). We will be using caustic and staining materials in the lab: expensive clothing can be ruined in the Microbiology Lab. An apron, lab coat, or any other loose long sleeved garment will be sufficient.
- 6. **Report any accident immediately**. Do not clean them yourself, contact the instructor immediately!
- 7. **Do not wash glassware**. All the glassware used in the Microbiology Lab **must be sterilized** before it can be washed. Discard racks and baskets will be provided.
- 8. **All markings must be removed from the glassware**. Prior to discard, all tape or wax pencil marks must be removed.
- 9. Plastics are discarded in Biohazard buckets for sterilization prior to disposal.
- 10. Reusable glass pipettes are discarded in **pipette jars** filled with disinfectant, be careful in placing pipettes into these jars as the pipettes may break, discard tips down.
- 11. Be sure to mark all your glass and plastic ware; unmarked items in the incubators will be discarded.
- 12. **Be prepared for each laboratory session**. The unprepared student will have difficulty finishing the material and writing the report in the time allotted.
