Welcome to the Fall 2024 issue of our department newsletter. As the year's end draws near, we reflect on the achievements of our community. I am delighted to share some of the recent successes of our Department of Earth and Environment. Our collective efforts continue to drive impactful research, innovative teaching, and meaningful community engagement. Our undergraduates have been actively involved in "out-of-the-classroom" learning experiences. Many of these revolved around undergraduate club activities. In 2024 we will have graduated 11 MS and 11 PhD students. I am incredibly proud of what we have achieved together and look forward to continuing our journey towards excellence in research, education, and community service.

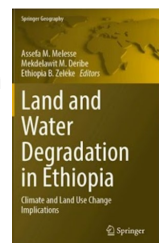
E&E doctoral student, **Chloe' Vorseth**, gave a TEDxMiramar talk on STEM education in June 2024.

In June, Professor **Florentin J. Maurrasse** was notified that the Council of The Geological Society of America, at its meeting on 6 May 2024, elected him to GSA Fellowship. Congratulations to Florentin on being recognized as an exceptional member of the geoscience community.

The abbreviated citation by PhD student **Miguel Valencia** was published on the GSA website and in the July issue of GSA Today:

“**Florentin J. Maurrasse** (Florida International Univ.): Dr. Maurrasse has a long and consistent history of excellence in administration of geoscience programs, training, mentoring, scientific achievement, and exemplary GSA-membership since 1972. He has made outstanding contributions to geoscience throughout Caribbean/Latin American regions and to understanding of paleoenvironments related to Cretaceous greenhouse climate and ocean oxygen depletion worldwide.”

Newly elected Fellows were recognized at the Presidential Address and Awards Ceremony held during the Connects 2024 meeting.

Dr. **Elizabeth Anderson**, a renowned freshwater conservation ecologist based at Florida International University, has been named the editor of the Freshwater Science Journal by Society for Freshwater Science (SFS). With a robust background in research, international collaborations, and leadership roles, including directing international research programs and coordinating conservation efforts in diverse landscapes, Dr. Anderson brings a wealth of experience to her new role. Her expertise, supported by prestigious grants from organizations like the MacArthur Foundation and National Geographic, underscores her dedication to understanding and protecting freshwater ecosystems. Dr. Anderson's appointment is poised to bolster SFS's mission of fostering scientific exchange and promoting conservation efforts in freshwater environments worldwide.

The FIU Institute of Environment has been awarded a three-year \$2.3 million grant as part of [NOAA's FY 2024 Marine Debris Challenge Awards](#). Led by Dr. Ali Ebrahimian, the project will use AI technology to enhance urban stormwater systems and reduce microplastic pollution. The team includes our Chair **Dr. Leonard Scinto**, Dr. Piero Gardinali, Dr. Hooman Vatankhah, Dr. Agoritsa Polyzou, Dr. Dongsheng Luo, and Dr. Anna Braswell, and will assess stormwater system performance and develop tools to identify and mitigate pollutants in urban coastal areas.

After hours of consultation with the reporters, **Mike Sukop's** sage quotes appeared in a Washington Post [article on septic systems](#): "Pretty gross" and "All bets are off" when sea level rises reflect his deep knowledge of the subject!

Latest News

A [recent study](#) led by **Dr Jennifer Rehage** discovered significant pharmaceutical contamination in bonefish, an important species in local marine ecosystems. The team found that the fish are primarily exposed to pharmaceuticals through their prey. Fifteen different drugs were detected in the bonefish, prey, and surrounding water. Some of the pharmaceuticals bioaccumulate in the fish, raising concerns about the potential long-term effects. The study estimated that bonefish consume up to 1.2% of a human daily dose of pharmaceuticals through their diet.

A team, including Dr. Brittany Harris, **Dr. Cara Rockwell**, and **Dr. Michael Ross**, along with MS students **Latonya Williams** and **Demonica Brown** is leading a project on Revitalizing Bahamian Pine Ecosystems: The Abaco Advanced Landscape and Ecosystem Monitoring The project is measuring the recovery of Bahamian pine forests damaged by Hurricane Dorian. Utilizing aerial and terrestrial LiDAR and the QUIC-Fire model, the project aims to enhance forest management and resilience. Partners include the Bahamas Forestry Unit, Bahamas National Trust, Friends of the Environment, USDA Forest Service, and The Jones Center at Ichauway. The project is also committed to capacity building in the Bahamas by training local students in advanced ecological and fire management techniques, ensuring the community can sustainably apply project findings in the future.



Graduate student **Joseph Anthony Navarro** has made history by winning the \$16,491 Student SARE grant, the first of its kind awarded to a student working in Puerto Rico. Advised by **Dr. Rockwell** and **Dr. Jayachandran**, Navarro's research focuses on using Taino agricultural methods to enhance soil health and crop production. His project, which examines the benefits of conuco mounds and intercropping practices, aims to tackle food insecurity and environmental challenges in Puerto Rico. Despite facing challenges like heavy rains, Navarro's work promises innovative solutions for sustainable agroecology in tropical regions.
